

# The nitty gritty on how to pay.

You now need to pay Yellow Pages Group® directly, so let's take a look at the different ways you can pay.

## **Cheque**

## **Internet Banking**

Pay directly online into our ANZ bank account (01-0242-0100194-00) and quote your Yellow Pages Group account number.

## **Cash**

Go into any ANZ branch with your payment slip and pay directly to the teller.
